PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: August 19, 2021

Welcome to Friends ("Friends," "Tristone," "we," "us" or "our"). This privacy policy ("Policy") describes how Tristone Partners LLC and its related companies ("Company") collect, use and share personal information of consumer users of this platform (the "App"). This Policy also applies to any of our other Apps that post this Policy. This Policy does not apply to Apps that post different statements.

- Our Privacy Policy explains how we and some of the companies we work with collect, use, share and protect information in relation to our mobile services, App, and any software provided on or in connection with these services (collectively, the "Service"), and your choices about the collection and use of your information.
- By using our Service you understand and agree that we are providing a
 platform for you to post content, including photos, comments and other
 materials ("User Content"), to the Service and to share User Content
 publicly. This means that other Users may search for, see, use, or share any
 of your User Content that you make publicly available through the Service,
 consistent with the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy and our Terms
 of Use (which can be found
 at https://www.friendsmobile.org/TermsOfUse.pdf).
- Our Policy applies to all visitors, users, and others who access the Service ("Users").

1. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect the following types of information.

Information You Provide Us Directly. We collect your first name, last name, password, email address, as well as other information you directly give us when registering for an account, creating a user profile, communicating with us (such as e-mail messages) or otherwise interacting with the Service. We also collect the User Content (e.g. photos, comments and other materials) that you post to the Service.

Information Automatically Collected. We automatically log information about you, your device and your usage. Here are some examples:

Log file information: We only log aggregated server usage data for billing purposes. None of the log data is device or user specific.

Metadata: Metadata is usually technical data that is associated with User Content. For example, Metadata can describe how, when and by whom a piece of User Content was collected and how that content is formatted. Users can add or may have Metadata added to their User Content including time of post or other data. This makes your User Content more searchable by others and more interactive. Meta data also includes user information including the last signed in date, and the date of user creation.

2. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

In addition to some of the specific uses of information we describe in this Privacy Policy, we may use information that we receive to:

- provide, operate, maintain, improve, test, and monitor the effectiveness of our Service
- diagnose or fix technology problems
- help you efficiently access your information after you sign in
- remember information so you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the Service;
- automatically update the application on your device
- send to 3rd parties for billing purposes

3. SHARING OF YOUR INFORMATION

We will not rent or sell your information to third parties outside Friends without your consent, except as noted in this Policy.

We may share personal information as follows:

- We may share personal information with your consent. For example, you
 may let us share personal information with others for their own marketing
 uses. Those uses will be subject to their privacy policies.
- We may share personal information when we do a business deal, or negotiate a business deal, involving the sale or transfer of all or a part of our business or assets. These deals can include any merger, financing, acquisition, or bankruptcy transaction or proceeding.
- We may share personal information for legal, protection, and safety purposes.
 - We may share information to comply with laws.
 - We may share information to respond to lawful requests and legal processes.
 - We may share information to protect the rights and property of Tristone Partners LLC, our agents, customers, and others. This includes enforcing our agreements, policies, and terms of use.
 - We may share information in an emergency. This includes protecting the safety of our employees and agents, our customers, or any person.

- We may share information with those who need it to do work for us.
- We may share User Content and your information (including but not limited to log files) with Service Partners or other third parties
- We also may share your information as well as information from tools like cookies, log files, and device identifiers and location data, with third-party organizations that help us provide the Service to you ("Service Providers"). Our Service Providers will be given access to your information as is reasonably necessary to provide the Service under reasonable confidentiality terms.

We may also share aggregated and/or anonymized data with others for their own uses.

Please note that once we share your personal information with another company, the information received by the other company becomes subject to the other company's privacy practices.

Parties with whom you may choose to share your User Content:

- Any information or content that you voluntarily disclose for posting to the Service, such as User Content, becomes available to the public. Once you have shared User Content or made it public, that User Content may be reshared by others.
- Any User Content that you make public is viewable by other Users and subject to use under our Friends Terms of Use, which incorporates the terms of this Privacy Policy.
- If you remove information that you posted to the Service, copies may remain viewable in cached and archived pages of the Service, or if other Users or third parties using the Service have copied or saved that information.

What happens in the event of a change of control:

 If we sell or otherwise transfer part or the whole of Tristone or our assets to another organization (e.g., in the course of a transaction like a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, dissolution, liquidation), your information such as name and email address, User Content and any other information collected through the Service may be among the items sold or transferred. You will continue to own your User Content. The buyer or transferee will have to honor the commitments we have made in this Privacy Policy.

Responding to legal requests and preventing harm:

 We may access, preserve and share your information in response to a legal request (like a search warrant, court order or subpoena) if we have a good faith belief that the law requires us to do so. This may include responding to legal requests from jurisdictions outside of the United States where we have a good faith belief that the response is required by law in that jurisdiction, affects users in that jurisdiction, and is consistent with internationally recognized standards. We may also access, preserve and share information when we have a good faith belief it is necessary to: detect, prevent and address fraud and other illegal activity; to protect ourselves, you and others, including as part of investigations; and to prevent death or imminent bodily harm. Information we receive about you may be accessed, processed and retained for an extended period of time when it is the subject of a legal request or obligation, governmental investigation, or investigations concerning possible violations of our terms or policies, or otherwise to prevent harm.

4. HOW WE STORE YOUR INFORMATION

Storage and Processing:

- Your information collected through the Service may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which Friends, its Affiliates or Service Providers maintain facilities.
- Friends and our Service Providers may transfer information that we collect about you, including personal information across borders and from your country or jurisdiction to other countries or jurisdictions around the world.
- By registering for and using the Service you consent to the transfer of information to the U.S. or to any other country in which our Service Providers maintain facilities and the use and disclosure of information about you as described in this Privacy Policy.
- Friends cannot ensure the security of any information you transmit to Friends or guarantee that information on the Service may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed.
- Please do your part to help us. You are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your unique password and account information, and for controlling access to emails between you and Friends, at all times.

5. YOUR CHOICES ABOUT YOUR ACCOUNT AND YOUR INFORMATION

If you would no longer like to have a Friends account, please email us at community@friendsmobile.org and state "DELETE ACCOUNT" in the re: line.

Following termination or deactivation of your account, Friends, its Affiliates, or its Service Providers may retain information (including your profile information) and User Content for a commercially reasonable time for backup, archival, and/or audit purposes.

6. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

We do not knowingly collect or solicit any information from anyone under the age of 13 or knowingly allow such persons to register for the Service. The Service and its content

are not directed at children under the age of 13. In the event that we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under age 13 without parental consent, we will delete that information as quickly as possible. If you believe that we might have any information from or about a child under 13, please contact us at community@friendsmobile.org.

7. OTHER WEB APPS AND SERVICES

We are not responsible for the practices employed by any Apps or services linked to or from our Service, including the information or content contained within them. Please remember that when you use a link to go from our Service to another App or service, our Privacy Policy does not apply to those third-party Apps or services. Your browsing and interaction on any third-party App or service, including those that have a link on our App, are subject to that third party's own rules and policies. In addition, you agree that we are not responsible and do not have control over any third-parties that you authorize to access your User Content. If you are using a third-party App or service and you allow them to access your User Content you do so at your own risk.
